

MEETING


Primary focus of the meeting was to align institutional goals between the administration and the teaching staff, focusing on academic excellence.

The day began with a special assembly where teachers took over the stage to surprise the students.


Tribute: The Principal and senior faculty members offered floral tributes to the portrait of Pandit Nehru.

AIRPORT FAMILARISATION



Location: Kempe Gowda International Airport, Bengaluru.

During the visit, students were introduced to the complex logistics of a major international hub. The following areas were highlighted:

Structure of Terminal 1, designed to handle high passenger volumes while utilizing natural light.

Terminal Operations: Understanding the distinction between landside (publicly accessible) and airside (restricted) zones.

Passenger Processing: A walkthrough of the departure flow, including security checkpoints, check-in bays, and the integration of "DigiYatra" biometric technology for seamless transit.

Ground Logistics: Observing the curb side management system for taxis, private vehicles, and public buses to ensure efficient traffic flow.
